If you are interested in becoming a Parish Councillor, please contact The Clerk for details of what is involved and how to apply. We meet bi-monthly in the School Hall at 8.00 pm and the meetings last for approx. 2 hours.

To qualify a person must on the day of election be a British subject or citizen of the European Union or Ireland and attained the age of 18 years AND

- (a) on that day is and therefore continues to be a local government elector for the area of the authority or
- (b) has during the whole 12 months preceding that day occupied as owner or tenant any land or other premises in the area or
- (c) their principal or only place of work during that twelve months has been in the area or
- (d) has during the twelve months resided in that area or
- (e) during the whole twelve months has resided in the parish or within 4.8 kilometers (3 miles) of it.

Disqualification from being elected a member is set out in Section 80 of the Local Government Act 1972.
